Syringe access services available 9am-1pm, every weekday except Wednesday. Free HIV, hep C, and STI testing Mon-Wed, 9am-1pm. Hep C navigation services and linkage to treatment offered. MAT services with same-day suboxone prescriptions available every Thursday.

Free hep C testing & treatment. Also offering STI treatment, PrEP & PEP, hormones, and sexual health services. Everyone is eligible, especially the LGBTQIA community. Clinic opens at 10am and same-day appointments are generally from 10:30am-12:30pm.
