470 Castro St. 415-581-1600 Tues-Sat 10am-7pm Free hep C testing & treatment. Also offering STI treatment, PrEP & PEP, hormones, and sexual health services. Everyone is eligible, especially the LGBTQIA community. Clinic opens at 10am and sameday appointments are generally from 10:30am-12:30pm.



730 Polk St. 4th floor 415-292-3400 Mon-Fri 1pm-4pm Hep C and HIV testing is offered Mon-Fri, 1pm-4pm. Hep C and harm reduction support group held every Tuesday, from 1pm-2pm. Drop-in hep C clinic is open after group on Tuesdays, from 2pm-4pm.
