HEPATITIS C





Hepatitis C virus (HCV) can cause long-term health problems, including liver damage, cirrhosis, liver cancer, liver failure, and even death.



HCV is passed through blood, often through sharing syringes or other equipment used to inject drugs. HCV can survive on open surfaces like cookers and tabletops for up to 6 weeks.



About 11,000 San Francisco residents are living with HCV, many of whom are unaware of their status.

HCV can be cured in just 8-12 weeks with oral medications.

Treatments are highly effective, have few side effects and are covered by most insurance plans including Medi-Cal and Medicare.
